**ACCEPTING HOUSING APPLICATIONS**

The City of Waycross will begin accepting housing applications for its CHIP Grant from owner-occupants immediately for homeowners living within the following neighborhoods only:

Census Tract 9508.02: Area bounded by Ketterer Street, N. Crawford Street, Carswell Avenue, Clinton Street, Jane Steet, and Perham Street.

On May 9, 2024 the City of Waycross was awarded a Community HOME Investment Program Grant in the amount of \$500,000 to provide decent, safe, energy efficient and affordable housing to low-moderate income individuals living in substandard housing within the above target area. It is anticipated that eight (8) homeowners will be helped by this grant for rehabilitation and/or reconstruction of their residences.

Assistance will be provided on a **first-come-first-served basis** by contacting Jacob Ryan of the Southern Georgia Regional Commission at (229) 333-5277 to be placed on the housing list/waiting list. After being placed on the list, an application will be mailed (or may be picked up) that must be fully completed and returned, in order to participate.
